## **Professional Career**

I have been investigating clinical significance of colonoscopy and enteroscopy for the diagnosis and the treatment of intestinal disorders. Magnifying colonoscopy, image-enhancing colonoscopy, capsule endoscopy, and double-balloon endoscopy are the major tools of my clinical research.

I was trained in animal experiments for investigating pathophysiology of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory druginduced enteropathy, ulcerative colitis, and Crohn's disease.

I have been evaluating genetic aspects of chronic inflammatory bowel disease in Japanese population by means of single nucleotide polymorphism analysis.

I have been a co-investigator of multicenter clinical trials. In particular, I have been involved in drug trials in inflammatory bowel diseases. I have extensive experience in cooperating with other research staff and personnel from the Ethics Committee and funding agencies
